Electronic Clinical Quality Measures (eCQMs) Annual Update Pre-Publication Document for the 2025 Reporting/Performance Period

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This document describes the versions of the standards and code systems used in conjunction with the updated eCQMs for potential use in the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) programs for the 2025 reporting/performance period. It is designed to help health information technology (IT)/electronic health record (EHR) developers, Eligible Clinicians, and Eligible Hospitals/Critical Access Hospitals prepare for 2025 reporting through transparent pre-release of the expected standards and code system versions.

Where and when to obtain updated eCQMs for 2025 reporting/performance period:

The eCQM annual update for the 2025 reporting/performance period will be available Spring 2024. Please sign up for and follow the <u>Electronic Clinical Quality Improvement (eCQI)</u> <u>Resource Center</u> and <u>CMS</u> listservs to receive updates and announcements on the eCQM specifications' publication and related content. The updated eCQMs will be posted on the <u>Eligible Clinician</u>, <u>Eligible Hospital/Critical Access Hospital</u>, and <u>Outpatient Quality Reporting</u> pages of the <u>eCQI Resource Center</u>.

Measures will not be eligible for the 2025 reporting/performance period unless and until they are proposed and finalized through notice-and-comment rulemaking for each applicable program.
